The concert is for children of all ages.

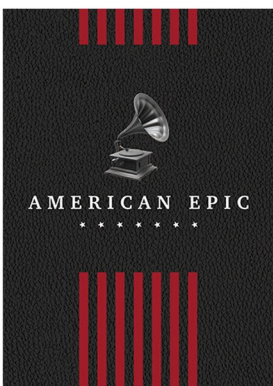
